

CHRISTMAS 2023

Thanks to each and every one that came out to unload, pack and delivery the Thanksgiving Food boxes.

If all goes as it has in the past, we will probably be asked to assist the same one hundred and nineteen families. The price of the Thanksgiving baskets cost us \$6100. Dollars. We are working to reduce this number as we realize it much greater than anticipated. One of the options is to seek some other cut of meat. Unfortunately, every idea suggested is only available FRESH and not frozen. We must use frozen due to the long time from pick up and our delivery to the school and then school dismissal time. Reduction of contents is also being considered. We do not wish to reduce the number of famines that we support.

Whatever financial support you can give will be greatly appreciated. We only have three weeks to gather the monies needed for promoting this ministry. Remember, God fed thousands with just five fish and five loaves of bread, can we not try to do likewise.?

Delivery date is scheduled for December 13^{th} . We need all the support, both financially and physically, that we can get. Our schedule for arrival of the truck will be on Tuesday (Dec 12^{th}) evening at 6 PM. We will unload the truck and begin setting up the assembly line. Several of the schools will be packaged this evening.

On Wednesday morning we will meet at 8:00 AM for completing the packing and delivery of the boxes. If all goes as planned, we should all be home no later than noontime.
