The Church year is divided into two parts. The first half from Advent to Pentecost is called the half year of our Lord. The gospel lessons focus on the actions of Jesus. The second half of the year is known as the half year of the Church. The gospel lessons focus on Jesus' teaching. That is why the liturgical color is green. This is a time for growth in Jesus' follower's knowledge and commitment to his mission.

We can always consider our glass half empty or half full. If we concentrate on the first one we might refer to the age of our congregation, our monthly deficits, or the decline in weekly attendance since the Covid pandemic.
